Grow Group Guide – Luke 1:11-17, 28-33

1. Background:

- a. The “right side of the altar” represents favor, so the angelic visit is positive. Zechariah thus represents faithful Israel found worshipping God in the temple.
- b. The angels announcement to Zechariah to not be afraid, and that his prayers have been heard is very similar to Gabriel’s announcement to Daniel in Daniel 10:12.
- c. As a young unmarried woman in a small town, Mary had virtually no social status. However, the angel lets her know that in Heaven she is viewed as “favored” and the “Lord is with” her. Others would see these greetings as too extravagant, even if she had social status.

2. Questions about the text:

- a. Compare and contrast the promises about John & Jesus.
- b. What parts of these promises would be hard to believe?
- c. How would these promises have been encouraging?

3. Application:

- a. What can we know about what God is hoping to see in our lives from the angel’s messages?
- b. What is one promise God has given that He might want you to have faith in?

4. Prayer

- a. Ask God for faith to believe in the promises He has given and the courage to live in accordance with those promises.
