CHURCH FAMILY BUDGET - In January, we, the church, voted a budget for 2017 in the amount of \$623,604, (And we are operating within that budget). To date donations for the Church Family budget are \$568,231 leaving a deficit of \$55,373. All contributions postmarked or donated on-line before midnight December 31 will be credited to you as tax-deductible contributions for 2017. Thank you for supporting our Church Family Budget.

Refurbishing Fundraising—several months ago we began a campaign to raise \$95,000 to refurbish two bathrooms, re-surface the flat portions of the Fellowship Hall roofs, re-carpet, and build a new audio/visual booth in the Fellowship Hall. The bathrooms are almost complete, the roof will be resurfaced in January, and by the end of February we hope to have the Fellowship Hall re-carpeted, with new modern replaceable carpet tiles, and the Audio/visual booth completed. (Similar to the one in the Youth Chapel). Thank you, church family for donating the funds as we continue to maintain and upgrade our facility.
