## ANNOUNCEMENTS

**CHURCH FAMILY BUDGET** - In January, we, the church, voted a budget for 2017 in the amount of \$623,604, (And we are operating within that budget). To date donations for the Church Family budget are \$597,933 leaving a deficit of **\$25,671**. All contributions postmarked, or donated on-line, before midnight December 31 will be credited to you as tax-deductible contributions for 2017. Thank you for supporting our Church Family Budget.

**2017 Contributions—Last minute contributions, to take advantage of the deduction for charitable giving for 2017, can be made by check and put in the church mailbox to the left of the Winding Way entrance until midnight, Sunday, December 31. The mailbox will be emptied first thing Monday morning.**

**Refurbishing Fundraising**—several months ago we began a campaign to raise \$95,000 to refurbish two bathrooms, re-surface the flat portions of the Fellowship Hall roofs, re-carpet, and build a new audio/visual booth in the Fellowship Hall. The bathrooms are almost complete, the roof will be resurfaced in January, and by the end of February we hope to have the Fellowship Hall re-carpeted with new modern replaceable carpet tiles and the Audio/visual booth completed. (Similar to the one in the Youth Chapel). Thank you, church family for donating the funds as we continue to maintain and upgrade our facility.

**Cars in the parking lots** - Please do not leave anything in your car that APPEARS to have value. Those who would break into a car do not know that the "backpack" has nothing of value in it. Although we monitor the parking lots, deacons cannot be everywhere at once, so please protect your property by following this simple rule.
