Grow Group Guide – 1 John 2:1-10

1. Background:

- a. Deuteronomy 5:11 forbids “taking the name of the Lord your God in vain”, or saying you are following God but not acting like it.
- b. In the previous chapter John has addressed those who are too lenient regarding sin; here he summarizes his point and guards against the opposite extreme: being too harsh regarding sin.
- c. Another way to translate “propitiation” is “atoning sacrifice”.

2. Questions about the text:

- a. How is John’s command both “old” and “new”?
- b. What about “the way Jesus walked” do you think John wants us to replicate?

3. Application:

- a. John sets up two ways to test the genuineness of a person’s commitment to following Jesus: (1) The absence of cherished sin and (2) the presence of obedient love. Is there anything you need to let go of so that you can grab hold of God’s love?

4. Prayer

- a. Ask God to give you the courage to admit areas you need to live differently, as well as the courage to know He forgives and empowers when you ask.
