Restoring the Thrill

Being people of the Bible we are drawn to stories of Divine movement in ways beyond the normal pattern of life. We love the stories of God speaking and moving - manna each morning, walking in the furnace, healing, and connecting people to hope!

Read: Hebrews 4:12, 2 Timothy 3: 16-17

Discussion Questions:

- Is God still moving or speaking today?
- Are we seeing or hearing?
- Is it reasonable to expect the Holy Presence today?

What scripture passages have most shaped your faith? Revisit those passages asking God to refresh the meaning and value in your life. List these stories and your story.

Read 2 Peter 1: 20-21

Give God permission each day to carry you along by His Spirit. Ask God to help you remain open to Divine leading in meeting people and facing situations in your life. Record those experiences.

Read the story of Acts 16: 6-10

- Where have you been instructed to be quiet? Have you been told to speak?
- When have you been drawn to a person or situation? What happened?

So does God speak today, as was done in Bible times? Write a prayer asking God to speak to you. Feel free to write out specific areas of life that are hungry for Divine presence.
