Promised Appearing!

The resurrection story became a reality when Jesus met with the disciples. Women first met Jesus and told them the glorious news. But they needed to experience Jesus for themselves.

This week, following the glory of Resurrection Celebration, please take the time to read John 20 and 21.

When have you been most disappointed? Most of us have already had times when it felt as if our world had fallen down around us. As you read this record of the death of Jesus, before the time of reunion, recall your deep losses.

Locked up out of fear: John 20:19-23. What are the most limiting fears that lock out joy and freedom from your faith life?

Have we locked out friends, family, God? Jesus walked into their presence to restore freedom.

What encounters in this room speak freedom to you? John 20: vs. 24-31, speaks of a second meeting. What is different about this session? Consider the special relation with Thomas. How do you relate to this interaction?

Chapter 21 of John tells the story of Jesus fixing breakfast on the beach.

It's early morning after deep hurt and mystery. Jesus once more reaches out to those close to Him.

What is the repeated message in these meetings? How often do you reach out to close friends?

If someone we know is locked up out of fear or other emotional hurt, how often, and in what different ways might we interact?
