**Biography of Reinhold Tilstra Released** - Connie Tilstra has written a biography of her husband Reinhold Tilstra. Reinhold was a much beloved pastor in Northern California for many years including Carmichael Church from 1972-1985. The book covers his teenage years in a concentration camp during World War II as well as his experiences as a pastor and Chaplain for the California Senate. In the midst of the full fury of World War II, Reinhold, at the tender age of thirteen, was being taken the next day from his mother to be imprisoned in a labor camp in Indonesia. On their last night together his mother said, "Son, I don't know when, or if, we will meet again on this earth. But please remember that the will of God will never lead you where the grace of God cannot keep you." And so the title "Sustaining Grace." The book is available now at the Northern California ABC and can be purchased either in person or online.
